

## Commercial Construction Planning Guide

This guide helps owners, developers, and facilities teams prepare commercial renovations, finish-outs, and new work before mobilization.

Define program requirements, occupancy goals, operating constraints, and decision rights in writing. Ambiguity at kickoff becomes change orders later.

Document landlord versus tenant responsibilities, after-hours work rules, life-safety continuity, and finish standards.

In North Texas, schedule around weather windows, municipal review timelines, and long-lead materials.

Treat permitting and inspections as schedule drivers. Confirm jurisdiction, occupancy type, and required drawings early.

Request proposals with clear inclusions and exclusions rather than relying on generic square-foot averages.

Use preconstruction to align scope, budget range, and sequencing before trades mobilize.
