

Fire Damage Recovery Guide

After fire damage, prioritize life safety, structural stability, and board-up or temporary protection.

Coordinate insurance notification and documentation when a claim will be filed.

Mitigation may include debris removal, odor/smoke considerations, and selective demolition defined by assessment.

Rebuild planning should clarify what returns to pre-loss condition versus code-driven upgrades required by the jurisdiction.

Occupied-adjacent work needs communication plans, access controls, and phasing assumptions.
