

Preconstruction Planning Guide

Preconstruction is the structured period to align scope, design information, procurement risk, and permit strategy before mobilization.

Owners and developers should confirm decision-makers, success criteria, and budget structure early.

Constructability reviews catch conflicts while changes are still inexpensive.

Sequence logistics for occupied sites, staging, and temporary protections.

Document assumptions that proposals rely on--especially incomplete drawings or allowance items.

A clear preconstruction record reduces disputes during construction.
